In 1927, Zenith introduced the first radio with push-button tuning, and in 1940 it broadcast the first FM radio station in the Midwest.

Raytheon and Zenith Electronics transistor radios soon followed and were priced even higher. In 1955, Raytheon's 8-TR-1 was priced at \$80 (equivalent to \$764 today). By November 1956 a transistor radio small enough to wear on the wrist and a claimed battery life of 100 hours cost \$29.95.
