measurements (which means they are 2 cm longer on each side), and take 2 cm off each sleeve. This way the shirt is less tight. • Loose fit: we add 20 cm to the hip, waist and chest measurements you provided. In addition, we add 8 cm to your shoulder measurements (which means they are 4 cm longer on each side), and take 4 cm off each sleeve.

Use a tailor's ruler and measure to the nearest quarter inch. Measure your chest at the widest point of the chest or across the bust. Measure your waist at the narrowest point of the waist. Measure your hips at the widest point on the hips.

How to Measure a Shirt - Modern Tailor - YouTube

Start measuring from the highest centre point of your thigh, at the crotch. Take off your shoes and stand with your legs slightly wide apart. Measure from the highest centre point of the thigh (below the crotch line) to the floor, following the natural shape of the inside leg. Pull the tape just taut enough.

How to take men's body measurements for tailored clothing ...

Back Width. With the person's arms by their side, measure across the back. Start at the back of the right armpit, continue measuring across the shoulder blades, and then stop at the back of the left armpit. Do not measure under the arms. This is the back part of the full chest measurement we took in step 2.

If I provided body measurements instead, Modern Tailor would have to apply it to their formula but I could never test if they worked accurately, since some manufacturers add six inches, while others might add four.

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Trouser Bottom round - This refers to the measurement of the flair of the leg for pants - Usually taken upwards of 12 inches. Inseam - Measured on the inside leg from the crotch to the where you want the hemline (to 1 1/4 cms above the ground/floor (for full-length pants)) Body Rise: You can measure this two ways 1.

Allowances will be made by the tailor. You'll need a flexible tape measure (inches) and someone to help you place and read the measuring tape. As we say in the tailor shop... "measure twice, cut once."... and you'll get more accurate measurements.

Women's Measurement Instructions for Custom Tailored ...

Length (neck to waist) - Measured down the spine. Length (waist to desired finished distance from floor) - Measured down the spine. Inseam - Measured from the crotch to desired finished distance from floor. Crotch Depth - Measured seated, on the side, from seat to waist.

Start measuring from the side base of your neck, at the top shoulder line, and going down towards your waist level passing over your bust point. Try to keep the tape as straight as possible. To measure bust depth, use the same starting point on the shoulder as your front waist length, measuring down to the apex of your bust point. 4.
